# Spiritual First Aid!



Every day we're seeing videos and advertisements on TV and Social Media that try to entertain us – distract us from our isolation, our worries, our pains and our fears. And for a brief moment – some of them are successful. But, let's be honest, it doesn't last. In the darkness of the night, or the

emptiness of the day, the oppression and uncertainty of life grips our very being. Impatience and frustration are beginning to take their toll – we want our independence back – we want to do what we want to do - when we want to do it!
